You will be discovering proper planting/propagation techniques working with medicinal botanicals. We will also be working outside during the Fall harvesting medicinal plants, drying them, and making herbal products. December will find you helping to plant the botanicals from seed readying them for the Spring shows (includes plant care and maintenance). Late February, early March seedlings will need to be transplanted into new containers preparing them for their last stage before going to market. January, February, and March there will be some outside work in the gardens, as weather permits, preparing soil for vegetable production. April seed planting begins in the greenhouse for summer produce. Late May we begin planting outdoors, as weather permits.
